PROCLAMATION NO. 60

EXTENDING THE PERIOD FOR THE SOLICITATION OF VOLUNTARY
CONTRIBUTION FOR THE UNITED NATIONS APPEAL FOR
CHILDREN

WHEREAS, the period fixed in Proclamation No. 57, dated February 26, 1948, for the active solicitation of voluntary contribution for the United Nations Appeal for Children has been found inadequate;

WHEREAS, there is need of extending the said period in order that the campaign may be made more effective and successful;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, MANUEL ROXAS, President of the Philippines, do hereby extend up to April 30, 1948, the period within which active solicitation of voluntary contribution for the United Nations Appeal for Children may be made.
