PROCLAMATION NO. 112

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 1966, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC  
HOLIDAY FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF LOS BAÑOS, PROVINCE OF  
LAGUNA.

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, Lyndon  
B. Johnson, will visit the International Rice Research  
Institute, U.P., College of Agriculture and the U.P.,  
College of Forestry located in Los Baños, Laguna on October  
26, 1966;

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the people of  
Los Baños be given full opportunity to welcome President  
Johnson;

NOW, WHEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of  
the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by  
Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby  
declare Wednesday, October 26, 1966, as a special public  
holiday in the Municipality of Los Baños, Province of  
Laguna.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and  
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be  
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 25th day of October,  
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
