PROCLAMATION NO. 250

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 23, 1967, AS A SPECIAL  
PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN CALOOCAN CITY.

WHEREAS, the 23rd day of August marks the seventy-  
first anniversary of the "Cry of Pugad Lawin", a historic  
event in our struggle for freedom; and

WHEREAS, the people of Caloocan City where the  
event took place should be given ample opportunity  
to celebrate the event with appropriate ceremonies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President  
of the Philippines, pursuant to the authority vested  
in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative  
Code, do hereby declare Wednesday, August 23, 1967,  
as a special public holiday in Caloocan City.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand  
and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines  
to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 22nd day of August,  
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
