PROCLAMATION NO. 269

DECLARING MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 1967, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC
HOLIDAY IN GUINOBATAN, ALBAY.

WHEREAS, Monday, September 25, 1967, marks the
60th anniversary of the surrender of General Simeon
Ola, one of the last generals to surrender during
the Filipino-American war; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guinobatan, Albay, should
be afforded an opportunity to render honors to the
honored General;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President
of the Philippines, by virtue of the authority vested
in me by Section 34 of the Revised Administrative Code,
do hereby declare Monday, September 25, 1967, as a
special public holiday in Guinobatan, Albay.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand
and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines
to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 23rd day of September,
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
