PROCLAMATION NO. 309

DECLARING JUNE 1994 AS PHILIPPINE ROTARY MONTH

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare June 1994 as "Philippine Rotary Month".
