

PROCLAMATION NO. 467

DECLARING SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2003, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ANTONIO, ZAMBALES, TO BE KNOWN AS DON TEODORO R. YANGCO DAY

**WHEREAS**, Saturday, November 9, 1861 marks the birth anniversary of Don Teodoro Rafael Yangco, an illustrious son of San Antonio, Zambales, who in his time earned the title "The Great Filipino Philanthropist" and "The Grand Old Man of Philippine Commerce"; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of San Antonio, Zambales, should be given full opportunity to commemorate the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.


