PROCLAMATION NO. 1886

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2009, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DINGLE, PROVINCE OF ILOILO

WHEREAS, the First Battle Cry of Revolution against Spain in the Province of Iloilo and Panay known as the "Cry of Lincud" happened on October 28, 1898 in the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo;

WHEREAS, to commemorate this historical event, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo, be given full opportunity to join the celebration.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO R. ERMITA, Executive Secretary, by authority of Her Excellency, GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, do hereby declare Wednesday, October 28, 2009, as special (non-working) day in the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo.
