PROCLAMATION NO. 312

DECLARING FRIDAY, 13 JANUARY 2012, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)  
DAY IN THE CITY OF SAN PABLO

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Pablo marks the feast day of its patron saint, St. Paul, the First Hermit, and the 416<sup>th</sup> founding anniversary of its parish on 13 January 2012;

**WHEREAS**, coinciding with the feast day is the holding of the 17<sup>th</sup> Coconut Festival and Street Dancing Competition (Mardi Gras);

**WHEREAS**, to enable the people of the City of San Pablo to celebrate the occasion, the Office of the Mayor requested that Friday, 13 January 2012 be declared as special (non-working) day instead of 15 January 2012, which falls on a Sunday;

**WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the City of San Pablo be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAQUITO N. OCHOA JR.**, Executive Secretary, by authority of His Excellency, **BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, do hereby declare Friday, 13 January 2012, as a special (non-working) day in the City of San Pablo.
